SU.PR.EME. 2 PROGRAM

The **Su.Pr.Eme.2 Program** is an **extraordinary and integrated five-year action plan of interventions to combat and overcome forms of labour exploitation, unlawful recruitment activities, including gangmaster practices and situations of marginalisation experienced by foreigners** across the five Southern Italian regions (Sicily, Calabria, Apulia, Basilicata and Campania).

Su.Pr.Eme.2 Program is financed by Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) 2021-2027 - Specific Objective 2 Legal Migration and Integration - Area of Application 2 h) integration measures and by the National Program for Inclusion and Poverty Reduction ESF+ 2021-2027 - Priority 1 "Support for social inclusion and poverty reduction" - Specific Objective ESO4.9) Promoting the socioeconomic integration of third-country nationals, including migrants. The partnership is led by the Sicilian Region, supported by the Regions of Basilicata, Calabria, Campania and Apulia and by Nova National Consortium for Social Innovation. Su.Pr.Eme.2 is part of the National Program for the Prevention and Fight against Undeclared Work and Unlawful Recruitment Activities (Gangmaster Phenomenon) of the Directorate-General for Immigration and Integration Policies of the Ministry of Labour and Social Policies. It intends to systematise, for the sake of continuity and innovation, the services, results and impacts achieved with the previous Su.Pr.Eme. and P.I.U.Su.Pr.Eme projects.

The program is divided into the following areas of activity:

WP1 - GOVERNANCE FOR INNOVATION

- **Tables to combat unlawful recruitment (gangmaster) activities** to define and share strategies and joint action plans
- **Institutional and community empowerment and Change Management support paths**
- **Support and empowerment** of migrant associationism to encourage their active participation
- **Mapping, sensitisation and engagement of the employment system** to promote societal-work inclusion paths and guide processes to support emergence
- **Research, study and awareness of the phenomenon**



WP2 - EMERGENCE LABORATORIES

- **Inter-institutional (anti-gangmaster) anti-unlawful recruitment help desk**, a specialist, multi-channel and multilingual service that aims to promote emergence and to facilitate access to information and services
- **Support for inspection task forces** in complementarity with other territorial interventions
- **Integration budget** with allocation to individual recipients from a pool of resources designed to support them on their path to socio-economic empowerment
- **Governance of emergence actions and inter-regional referral mechanism** for the integrated action of all interventions

WP3 - CULTURAL ECOSYSTEM INTEGRATION

- **Integrated social hubs** for multidimensional undertakings
- **Proximity actions:** territorial linguistic and intercultural outreach and mediation
- **Transport bolstered by intercultural mediation activities**
- **Inclusive housing measures** aimed at dignified migrant living conditions, also through co-housing actions and independent living pathways
- **Orientation and strengthening of skills** for recipients
- **Innovative social agriculture pilot projects** to support recipient entrepreneurship
- **Strengthening of Employment Centres** and supply/demand job matching services

WP4 - MAINSTREAM AWARENESS

- **Communication and information plan**
- **Social media management, digital communications, press office**
- **Interregional training course for journalists and communicators**
- **Events, awareness and promotional campaigns**
- **Storytelling and narration** ("Beyond the ghetto")

RECIPIENTS

The project is aimed at approximately **18 thousand migrant workers** employed mainly in the agricultural-food sector and in other production sectors at risk of labour exploitation in the **five regions involved**.
